



What is education?

The English dictionary definition of education is "the process of receiving or giving systematic instruction, especially at a school or university". But Bhagawan said "Education is of two types. The first type is a collection of facts and knowledge about the external world and sharing them with students. The second type is Educare. Educare involves the deep understanding of the knowledge that springs from within and imparting it to students. But todays education gives the students knowledge only about the external world". Education in schools is where we learn about the world as Swami said. We as students learn how the world operates by learning from mistakes made in the past, learning math that helps us buy or sell things and many more. The End of Education is Character. We have all heard the famous quote by Swami, but what does it really mean? In todays society, an education given by institutes are essential in order to make a living. Students pursue higher education in hopes of becoming more and more successful. Swami tells us that there are two types of education. The first one is facts and knowledge about the external world, and sharing them with students. The second type of education is educare. Educare involves the deep understanding of the knowledge that springs within. An example would be love in the form of compassion. If we perform compassionate or kind acts towards others and make them happy, subconsciously there are some parts of our brain that feels that same happiness that we have created for others. In essence, when we make others happy, we make ourselves happy as well.

And, when we share others sorrows, the other person feels healed, and internally we feel empowered that we have something valuable to contribute. Educare is that which establishes love and kinship between fellow human beings. Swami tells us that, the secular education that most follow is not enough. It needs to be supplemented by spiritual education: education without culture is like a kite with a broken string. No one knows where it will fall and what damage it will cause to others. Therefore, such education does not benefit anyone. The best example swami gives is of Prahalad as he lived up the well referenced quote. At any given point in time, he followed the values he had been taught and practiced it 24/7, even given the abusive nature of his father. By upholding the human values we have learned, we can all live up to the statement: the end of education is character.
